1	Participate in Job Fair	On April 7, 2016, our SEU participated in a job fair sponsored by Mercyhurst College. SEU representatives spoke with attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting as well as job openings within the SEU and accepted resumes from interested candidates. SEU participants included our Promotions Coordinator and Promotions Assistant.
2	Participate in Job Fair	On August 31, 2016, our SEU participated in a job fair sponsored by Erie Times News at the Bayfront Convention Center. SEU representatives spoke with attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting as well as job openings within the SEU and accepted resumes from interested candidates. SEU participants included our Promotions Director.
3	Participate in Internship Fair	On November 1, 2016, our SEU participated in an internship fair at Edinboro University of Pennsylvania. SEU representatives spoke with attendees about internship opportunities in broadcasting as well as internships openings within the SEU and accepted resumes from interested candidates.
